Clubmark

Sport England Clubmark is used by national governing bodies of sport as part of their club accreditation programmes for sports clubs with junior sections in recognition of a quality club. Clubmark is promoted by the England and Wales Cricket Board (ECB). The Southern Premier League that governs the leagues that the Club's first and second teams play in now has a policy that every club in the Premier Division shall have obtained Clubmark to maintain their current status.

Clubmark accreditation addresses inclusiveness, diversity and child protection issues such that confidence is given to parents when choosing a club for their children. Totton & Eling were one of the first local clubs to achieve Clubmark Accreditation in 2006. We achieved reaccreditation in 2009 and again in 2012, and, are in the process of reviewing all our policies and procedures ready for reaccreditation in 2015.

Mandy Knight, the Junior Section Coordinator, oversees all of our coaches and volunteers (where required) ensuring they are DBS checked where appropriate. Additionally, all of the Club's ECB qualified coaches are Appointed First Aiders and have attended the Safe Practice Working with Children workshop (formally known as the Good Practice and Child Protection).
